

## FACILITIES

St. Tinney is a small, family run and family orientated holiday park. Our lodges and cottages are all graded as "FOUR STAR" by Visit Britain and we are graded and inspected every year. We let the lodges all year round & our static caravan holiday homes are let from Easter to the beginning of November. The camping fields are open from Easter until the end of September. The cost of Gas & Electricity usage is included in our caravan holiday homes tariff. Use of Gas & Electricity, including gas central heating, to all lodges is charged by £1 coin meter.

All bed linen (sheets, duvets & pillows) is provided, free of charge, to all lodges & caravans and all beds are made up ready for visitor's arrival. Bath and hand towels are provided to the lodges, but not to the caravans. Accommodation is let from 15:00 on the day of arrival and we ask that the accommodation is vacated by 10:00 on the day of departure.

### THE ST. TINNEY ARMS ON-SITE LICENCED BAR & GAMES ROOM

Our on-site club bar (the St. Tinney Arms) is open from the 19th March until 29<sup>th</sup> October 2011 and from the 31<sup>st</sup> March to the 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2012. Cooked food is served every evening, please see the chalk boards outside for opening hours as these change throughout the year. Snacks, confectionery & soft drinks can be purchased from vending machines in the Games Room.

### GROCERY DELIVERIES

TESCO, ASDA and WAITROSE will all deliver grocery orders direct to St. Tinney Farm. These can be ordered online via their respective websites, but please ensure that you are present to receive the order.

Our local Post Office and General Stores at Marshgate, also has a comprehensive range of groceries, etc., and supermarkets can be found at Launceston, Bude and Camelford. All of our lodges have fullsize upright fridge freezers, but the caravans only have an under the counter fridge with small freezer compartment.

### OUTDOOR HEATED SWIMMING POOL

Constructed in 2007, our outdoor heated swimming pool is open from 26<sup>th</sup> May to 8th September 2012, weather permitting. Please see the signs outside the pool for exact daily opening hours. We ask that children under 18 are accompanied by an adult at all times.

### NATURE TRAIL

Visitors of all ages can explore our farm & Nature Trail, with its professionally designed information boards and quiz leaflets, which can be obtained free of charge from reception.

### LAUNDRY ON SITE

Our professionally installed commercial laundry is open all year round and contains 2 washing machines, 2 tumble driers, an ironing board and steam iron.

### COARSE FISHING ON SITE

Those wishing to fish in our FIVE coarse fishing lakes, must purchase a St. Tinney Farm Fishing Permit immediately upon arrival. Fishing is charged at **£15 per rod, per person, per week or part week. These fees cover fishing in all five lakes.** As with all UK fisheries, Anglers must also be in possession of a UK Non-Migratory Trout and Coarse Rod Licence (sometimes called a Fishing Licence), which is issued by the Environment Agency. ### INTERNET ACCESS

Wireless Broadband Internet access, is available free of charge in all self catering accommodation and communal areas, but is offered on a best endeavour basis, with no technical support provided. If you require internet access for "Business Critical" work or otherwise, we recommend that you bring your own 3G wireless connection "Dongle".

### FACILITIES NEAR BY
